**(i) Risk criteria to classify industries such as High, Medium and low risk under CIS based on the Periodicity of Inspection and verification at least**  
As per Rule 27 of Legal Metrology (General) Rules, 2011

S No.	Description of Weight or measure to be inspected and Verified	Risk	Periodicity
1.	All weights, capacity measures, length measures, tape , beam scale and counter machine	Low	twenty four months
2.	Storage Tanks	Medium	sixty months
3.	All weight or measure including tank lorry <i>other than</i> weights, capacity measures, length measures, tape, beam scale and counter machine and storage tanks	High	twelve months
